1. Call to Order 7:01 PM EST Joe

2. Approval of the Agenda Joe

3. WINR Update..... Lori, April
April and Lori will be joining us at the next meeting with an update.
4. Minutes Approval Lu Ann
Motion #1
To approve the minutes from July 2025 meeting.
Maker: Paul Hurley, Second: Michele Weiss
Discussion: Lewis asked about the minutes actually being marked approved for him to put on the website.
Passed: Unanimously.

Joe announced that Rocco and Valarie at Nautical Nudists Inc won the biggest percentage of growth in the Nation with 88.24%. Congratulations!

5. Government Affairs Team Update
 - A. GAT Update Paul
Discussion about Hawaii and Little Beach. It is still illegal to be nude on the beach, but they are not enforcing it as much.
They had a healthy discussion about state bills referencing the confluence of nudity, alcohol assumption and minors. It seemed to be aware that many of the GAT members were not informed fully of the gravity of this situation with some of the legislation that has gone through Florida. We need to get the word out that whatever happens in Florida and California is a precursor to what happens nationwide. Make sure that they understand that AANR is working in the background to shape the language to get a better outcome. There were some comments about Blind Creek Beach, and it all had to do with not having signs about clothing optional. Now that signs are out, complaints have decreased.

There was discussion with Treasure Coast Naturists and some others about the e-mail that Joe sent out and it would be beneficial for us to have the discussion with the clubs about what is going on in the state legislature.

Joe noted that in Tim’s report it said that AANR-FL walked from the lobby efforts and that we need to make sure that the story is broadcast during the GAT meetings.

B. Website Policy Review Joe
Joe is working with the clubs asking them to submit or post on their website all their policies. And hope to be able to have a gold seal on the website showing that this is a safe family friendly oriented resort/club and we are clean. Joe asked if he could put together a draft statement of what it means to have family friendly nude recreation, moderation, child supervision.

6. AANR Updates..... Ralph, Joe
Ralph updated us with the Awards that were given to Florida personal. Joe Rives was given Man of the Year, the Nautical Nudists Inc club was given the biggest percentage growth, and Judy Mason who works in the AANR office was given the Woman of the Year.

There was no talk about how to increase the membership, but one thing we did learn that Florida is the only region that took advantage of the car show. He was very surprised that no other club in the nation even took advantage of this.

Joe thinks Florida's regional meetings are more of substance than the AANR National meeting and Max Schuttauf agreed with Joe's comment.

Mac asked if there was an executive session at the meeting. Ralph said no. Mac mentioned the discrimination policy that the AI committee approached him about back in the spring and mentioned what was determined.

Joe mentioned that Playalinda will be closing some of the area and moving the beaches around. There is a virtual session on September 3rd along with several other meetings. Erich is attending the first meeting and Joe and Ralph will be attending one also. There seems to be continuous harassment of nudists with children at this beach.

7. Fiscal Matters

A. July Financials.....Mac
Mac mentioned that we have increased dues for the past 2 months. July was up 6.4% month to month, which brought it to 1.76% for the year. He has also asked the Board to review the budget that he sent out on Aug. 3rd.

B. FY26 Budget DevelopmentMac
AANR-Florida is no longer going to be AANR's ATM. We will contribute \$3,000 to a political consultant plus a little more if necessary once AANR justifies what they are doing. Mac is wanting this budget to be ratified before November so we can spend the January meeting working constructively talking about club liaison. And to use the budget money to effectively deal with public relations and the club liaison.

There was much discussion between the Board of Members about the past payments for a lobbyist. Basically, we need to stick to our proposed budget until there is disclosure and accountability.

C. AANR GAT Cost Recovery Joe

D. Status of 2024 Dues Increase Joe
Lewis had questions about this increase. We tabled the motion and then came back with a letter for directs. Then we introduced the concept of the 2 tier dues structure, and we tried to get it with directs. Joe wants the finance committee to model dues increase for

the regional dues increase. Joe is going to rewrite Motion 17 that has been a part of this discussion.

8. Old Business..... Joe

A. Membership Growth Plan (see attached).

No motion for this. So, it is tabled again.

Discussion about the AANR dues that we will receive in the following year. Mac feels that memberships will be down 10%. Mac feels that we cannot support a growth plan until AANR defines their act. Paul thinks we need to look at the plan going forward without Cypress Cove as they are the club that is losing the most members as they have an estranged relationship with the leaders at AANR.

B. Set Mid-Winter Meeting Date

Motion passed unanimously

C. Haulover Membership Recruitment

Ralph and Joe were supposed to go to Haulover in September, Joe got one date and Ralph got another date, so they are going to try again in November.

Joe mentioned that with a permit in advance of setting something up on the Beaches of Federal Land. Ralph is going to check on this more to see if you can hand out brochures.

9. New BusinessMac

B. Officer Terms

Joe mentioned the suggestion motion that was brought up in the regional meetings about 2 years ago. This was to allow President and Vice Presidents to have 3-year terms instead of 2-year terms. It was tabled due to the discussion that it needs to be rewritten as there could be a fiscal impact. Mac asked for this to be tabled to the next meeting as we need to challenge people to consider what they think about officers having 3 (three) 2-year terms.
