1. Call to Order 7:01 PM EST Joe

2. Approval of the Agenda Joe
Ralph wants to add something about Facebook and Cape Canaveral. Joe said to do that when he does AANR Updates.
3. Minutes Approval..... Lu Ann
Motion to approve the November Board Meeting Minutes.

4. Government Affairs Team Update
 - A. GAT Update Paul
Paul discussed the case with 3 children involved; it was adjudicated and it did not go to court. There are increasing challenges to parental rights when a nudist resort is involved. There was a topless sunbather cited for disorderly conduct in Palm Beach. Public defender submitted a brief to the court and AANR submitted an amicus brief, and it went well. In the NE there is an issue dealing with “Virtual Pornography” and there is a bill that was designed to regulate minors depicted nude and it was pending in the ways and means committee at the state level. AANR submitted matters to the chair to the senate ways and means committee.

Not just in the state of Florida but now spreading through the country the issue is that the people are equating nudism with child grooming. Child pornography is defined in court records and previous cases, but there is a new category now call CSAM – Child abuse Sexual Material. The concern that AANR has is that a change in terminology can change the definition to include nudism and family friendly nudism where minors are involved.
 - B. Lobbyist Activities Paul and Joe
Ramon’s report focused on a few items. One was the candidates for 2026, Second was CSAM that Paul discussed and the third was Child Protection, which continues to be an issue in Florida. When the session starts there is proposed legislation requiring background check at public pools and he is watching proposed legislation regarding grandparents’ visitation rights.
 - C. Florida Code of Conduct..... Joe
Joe discussed the draft that he sent to the Board of Directors and is asking the Board of Directors to look it over and suggest any changes. He would like to vote on this at our Hybrid Meeting in January.
 - D. Economic Impact Study Update Joe
All this work of children’s nudity and alcohol has kept us from going forward, in the mid-winter meeting there will be a video that is kind of the dos and don’ts when you are at an AANR club. The point of the

brochure is if you are not friendly to nudism or if you're not sure, the brochure is text heavy and not nude pictures.

Joe has all the data needed by John Heather and will send it to Ralph and John. Joe is going to send the new template to the board of directors of non-landed clubs and ask them to go through it and input and ask how long it took.

5. AANR Updates Ralph

Ralph discussed the group on Facebook that is called Canaveral Naturists. He is looking into the suit that was filed with a different group that has never gone to trial and has been pending for many years and Erich is keeping an eye on this. With so many members of this group, why are we not getting membership from them. The one problem with getting advertisement on this beach is the Federal regulations do not allow you to do any recruitment on the beach. Paul mentioned that BG has mentioned that there is a permit process that you can go through to get permission to have some sort of information either in the parking lot or on the beach.

Joe and Ralph had discussion about the charter for Treasure Coast Naturists which had been revoked. Joe is going to question this as he has been asked to attend one of their board meetings and on the membership report it says the charter was revoked in August of 2025.

6. Fiscal Matters

A. Fiscal Matters..... Mac

Mac just summarized the report that he had sent out to the Board of Directors. Mac thinks that going into 2026 as long as we monitor what we spend with AANR and don't have an economic impact we should have a flat year. He does not see any growth happening as with what is going on politically and he is concerned about some membership in our larger clubs. He then discussed the changes that Lu Ann and him are making to the financial reports.

B. Treasurer's Report..... Lu Ann

Lu Ann went over the amounts that are in the operating account and the accounts and noted that she will be moving \$3,336.67 that is the 2026 dues paid into the operating account. Lu Ann discussed the amounts received in December, \$2,036. \$1,808 was for the year 2025 and the remainder is for restricted funds (upcoming years). She discussed the amounts received from the 3 largest clubs and from the directs so everyone can be aware of which club is doing the most and this past month it was Lake Como.

Lu Ann also mentioned that Dave had said that he is almost a 100% AANR club but has some members that are directs or members of other clubs. So, his numbers as published on the AANR membership count will not match the actual number of members in his club.

Joe mentioned that AANR East is trying to do something different and he wants to learn more about this to bring to us soon. As he looks it appears they are forming a club that includes direct members.

Then Lu Ann discussed the upcoming expenses for the month of January and asked Margaret to get her a list of the dates when HostGator takes money out so she can add this to her reports.

C. Fundraising IdeasLu Ann and Josh

Josh discussed that we need to find some ways to take some payments and open the accounts as AANR-FL so the money would go directly to AANR-FL operating accounts. We decided on Square, PayPal and Venmo. We discussed drafting a letter requesting donations along with ideas of what we are looking for and showing the upcoming events where we would use those donations.

We also brainstormed some locations that are near nudist friendly organizations that we could target for donation requests. We also discussed asking for donations of products or baskets from lifestyle clubs, as we feel that they could still make donations and make contributions towards our organization since we do share some common struggles and battles that we may face down the road and hoping they would help to support our efforts.

Lu Ann asked about sending the solicitation for GAT donations letter to Jeff Baldassarre to send to the Florida e-mails and Joe said yes after we all have consensus. Joe mentioned that with Jeff if you remind him that you would like a report on how many sent to and then how many opened. Josh will be sending the drafted letter to the Board of Directors so they can approve it at the next meeting. Ralph thinks this should be sent to the AANR Nationwide e-mails. So, this is now going to be a Florida e-mail for FL GAT donations and then a fund raising for resorts to be on the nationwide e-mails. Josh and Lu Ann will now figure out a way to sort this out. Joe asked Paul to help think this through and he is willing to help.

7. Old Business

- A. 2026 Midwinter Meeting (Good to go?)..... Joe
Debbie mentioned that the last time they discussed the Regional Convention they did not get the feeling that they had got confirmation that Lake Como would be holding the meeting. Joe let her know that we need the application for the bid. Lu Ann explained what it is that we need and how the board votes on the bids. Then the resort that gets the bid will fill out the contract.

- B. Sunbiz.org Discussion..... Lu Ann
Lu Ann mentioned that as a Florida State Business you are supposed to file an annual report every year. Several of our clubs she could not find on sunbiz.org. She sent a list of the clubs that were not found or inactive to Joe Rives and Mac Fleck. The issue we were concerned about was that the clubs would be upset and tell us that it is their business. Mac mentioned that once we get the Club Ambassador program and the Club Liaison Program going and as we are meeting with our clubs we mention it at that time. Ralph mentioned sending out a general memo to all the clubs to make sure they are following the requirements in Florida. And then you can follow up individually with each club. Joe said he would take this task on.

8. New Business

- A. Membership Growth Certificates..... Joe
We all know that there is tension between AANR and one of the biggest clubs. The membership report just came out and if you were to pull them out our membership would be up 2.9% and our club's growth factor would be up 7.1%. Joe would like to give membership certificates with your approval at the summer meeting to any club that experienced growth throughout the year to reinforce people are doing good things. Paul also mentioned giving the clubs an AANR garden flag also.

Ralph mentioned that he thinks that we should donate some money to SVR's Veteran Fund as we will not be having an actual meeting. Mac mentioned that there is \$1,000 in the trustee fund for 2026, and Ralph said yes and Joe suggested \$500. Lu Ann asked for this to be a Motion. It will be done at the January meeting.
