4. GAT Update.....Paul
Not much going on. There are a couple of bills that Erich is working with that prohibit nude computer images without records of consent and failure to provide the documents could incur penalties of \$10,000 per day. Erich is still working with the government's office for a veto on that.
Joe mentioned that they are trying to restrict access to a nude beach in Hawaii. The AANR West is trying to come up with funds for this, they just did not have a quorum to pass it during their meeting, so they will get that resolved and move on with funding this.

- A. Website Update Joe

Margaret did notice that some of the pages need to be updated and the one that mentioned the Veterans Update page and Lu Ann is going to send her the Approved minutes for the year 2026.
- B. Insurance (also in June Newsletter)..... Joe
Paul discussed what he learned from a company that is excited about partnering with AANR and providing insurance for the AANR clubs. They are much lower in costs. The



company is very savvy about asking what licenses you are supposed to have and if you don't have them all you will have discuss with the insurance company. They offer full coverage, liability, officer insurance, umbrella coverage, and all sorts of ancillary options depending upon the club's requirements.

Background Checks – Paul did find a company that has offered a proposal and a cost. They individually customize every club, so you can get into their system and find what you need per your requirements, and per what you contracted to receive.

Joe then mentioned that there was a club support committee and worked with 4 vendors on background checks and AANR is going to Pilot test on 3 clubs. It is called Checks pass and it is free to members.

Joe to make sure that this letter is also in the Newsletter.

Dave mentioned that there was an IA investigation into the Nude Podcast, and he has noticed that it is not on the website anymore. Joe knows nothing about whether this is a continuing investigation. The outcome is reported back in General to the members. So, if we don't hear something in August, then we will have to check into this.
